Fraudulent website alert

Hong Kong – March 6, 2025 – China Construction Bank (Asia) (“CCB (Asia)” or the “Bank”) would like to alert its customers and the general public the following fraudulent websites and suspicious internet banking login screens (please see below screenshots). The Bank would like to declare that it has no connection with such websites, and remind all customers and the public to stay vigilant and not to provide any personal data to such websites.
