Hong Kong – April 20, 2023 – China Construction Bank (Asia) (“CCB (Asia)”, “the Bank”) would like to alert its customers and the general public on fraudulent mobile application (App) purported to be from CCB (Asia).

The Bank has reported the above incidents to the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and the Hong Kong Police Force, and will take any action deemed necessary and appropriate to protect its reputation and the interests of its customers and the general public.
